OUR CURRICULUM

Our Learning and developmental program is based on the National Early Years Learning Framework for Australia. This framework is based on current research of early childhood development, and the aim of the framework is to extend and enrich children's learning from birth to five years and through to the transition to formal schooling.

The framework see's relationships as the basis for learning.
Relationships with family (the child's first and most important teachers), community, culture and land, are all important for learning. When they play and wonder, explore the world and come up with new ideas they are actively learning.

Belonging:

Knowing where and with whom you belong – is an integral part to human existence. Children belong first to family, a cultural group, a neighbourhood and a wider community. In early childhood, and throughout life, relationships are crucial to a sense of belonging. Belonging is centre to being and becoming in that it shapes who the children are and who they can become.

Being:

Childhood is the time to be, to seek and make meaning of the world. It is about the present and then knowing themselves, building and maintaining relationships with others, engaging with life's joys and complexities, and meeting challenges in everyday life. The early childhood years are not solely preparation for the future but also about the present.

Becoming:

Children's identities, knowledge, understandings, capacities, skills and relationships change during childhood. They are shaped by many different events and circumstances. Becoming reflects this process of rapid and significant change that occurs in the early years as young children learn and grow. It emphasises learning to participate fully and actively in society.

SCHOOL READINESS

At Naremburn Early Learning Centre children who succeed in school and in life know how to find solutions to problems. Our children can communicate and work well with others. They are curious, creative thinkers, and they continue to learn and adapt. Our high-quality preschool program helps your child build and utilise these skills every day.

These are common recounts of our preschoolers having fun and learning a lot through their play;

"Samuel and Travis build a ramp for their toy cars and test how fast the cars go when the ramp is at different angels."

"On a class nature walk, William notices that the leaves, which were once green, are now red, orange and yellow. He asks his teacher why the leaves are changing colour."

"At the dramatic play centre, Sophia, Jacob and Hannah set up a pretend doctor's office. They take turns role-playing as the doctor, receptionist and patient."

"Whilst Miss Jess is sitting with a small group of children making play dough, exploring colour, following the directions of the recipe and taking turns to pour and stir the ingredients."

Preschool age children are changing so rapidly, one minute your child is begging you to play lego with him, the next they are drawing a robot he and his friend want to build.

Our carefully trained teachers think carefully about when, how, and where to help your child's overall growth and development. We utilise every opportunity to help children learn – including meal times, clean up, and outdoor play time.

No two pre-schoolers are the same, and we use what we know about your child and set

individual goals for them. We keep track of their learning, so we know what they are ready to learn next to encourage children

to continue to thrive and challenge themselves.

NUTRITION

At Naremburn Early Learning Centre we have a four week rotatating seasonal menu, providing children with a variety of nutritious foods for Morning Tea, Lunch, Afternoon and Late Snack.

There is a daily menu board located near in the foyer, and menu suggestion forms are also available. We put a huge amount of love and effort into providing quality nutritious meals, and welcome all your feedback and suggestions.

We employ a qualified cook who serves all meals on-site daily, the children participate in daily cooking experiences and enjoy meal times in our community café inspired dining area.

FEE INFORMATION

Naremburn Early Learning Centre is open from 7:00am-6:30pm, Monday to Friday, 52 weeks per year (closed public holidays).

Once a child is enrolled at our centre, fees are payable for all booked days of care including; absence for illness, public holidays, vacations etc.

At NELC we have a two-day minimum enrolment policy; with one of these days being either a Monday or Friday.

HOW TO PAY

All fees are paid on a fortnightly basis through our direct debit system, families can choose to have these come out of a preferred bank account or credit card.

Fees are to be paid on commencement 2 weeks in advance as well as payment for the current week.

Families will receive a statement each week detailing the amount due and all fees will be deducted on a Thursday.

FEES

Nursery Rooms - 0-2years - \$145

Toddler Rooms - 2-3years - \$145

Preschool Rooms - 3-5years - \$128

BOND

To secure your child's place at NELC we require a \$400 fully refundable bond. We also require a \$50 non refundable admin fee.

LATE FEE

If your child is collected from our centre after 6:30pm, you will be charged a late fee of \$2.00 per minute. This will be added to your account to allow for remuneration to our team for their over time.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

It is the policy of our centre that four weeks (28 days) written notice be given before you withdraw your child from our centre. Any fees owing during this period will be deducted from your bond payment or passed onto a debt collector.

Under family assistance law, it is requirement that a child must attend on the last day of attendance; if attendance does not occur, the government benefits is NOT payable, therefore, fees will be charged at **FULL** fees up until the last day of attendance.

ENROLMENT INFORMATION

IT is a legal requirement that families ensure they sign in and out of the centre each day they attend. These records are used in case of emergencies and for the calculation of CCR.

HEALTH

To minimise the spread of infection at our centre, as per the NSW Health guidelines children with certain infections are excluded from attending. If your child displays any symptoms at the centre we will contact you to collect your child as soon as possible.

IMMUNISATION

The government has implemented a no jab no play legislation that requires all children to be fully vaccinated unless they have a medical exemption to be enrolled in childcare. Please ensure that we have your child's up to date immunisation at all times or this could affect your child's subsidy.

MEDICATION

IF your child requires medication whilst at the centre, a medication form must be filled out by a parent/carer. The medication must be accompanied by a prescription label or a doctors letter which states who the mediation is for, frequency and the dosage to be given.

MEDICAL CONDITION

If your child has a medical condition we must receive a medical management plan for a registered practitioner, and your child's medication must be on site at all times your child is in attendance. It is a requirement that these plans be reviewed by your doctor at least annually.

WHAT TO BRING

0-2years;

- A hat
- Comfort items eg; dummies, bottles
- Water Bottle
- Two labelled set of weather appropriate clothing

2-5 years;

- A change of weather appropriate clothing
- A hat
- Any comfort items
- Water Bottle
